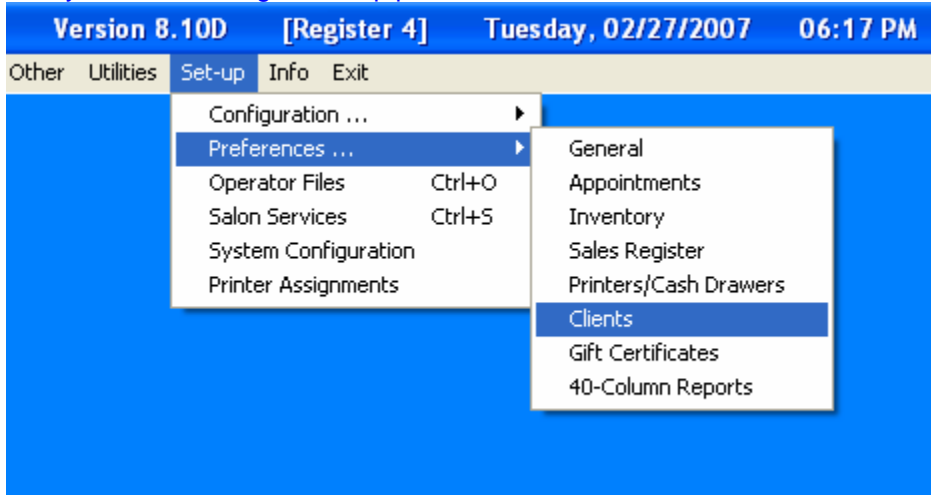
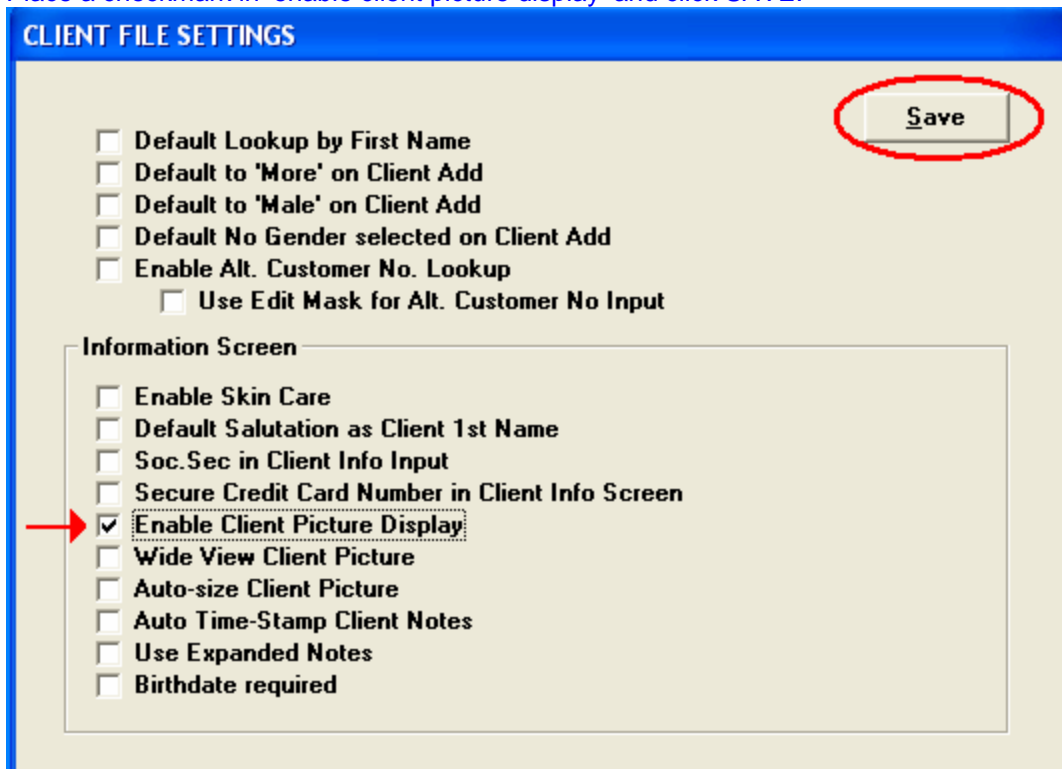


ENABLING THE CLIENT PICTURE DISPLAY

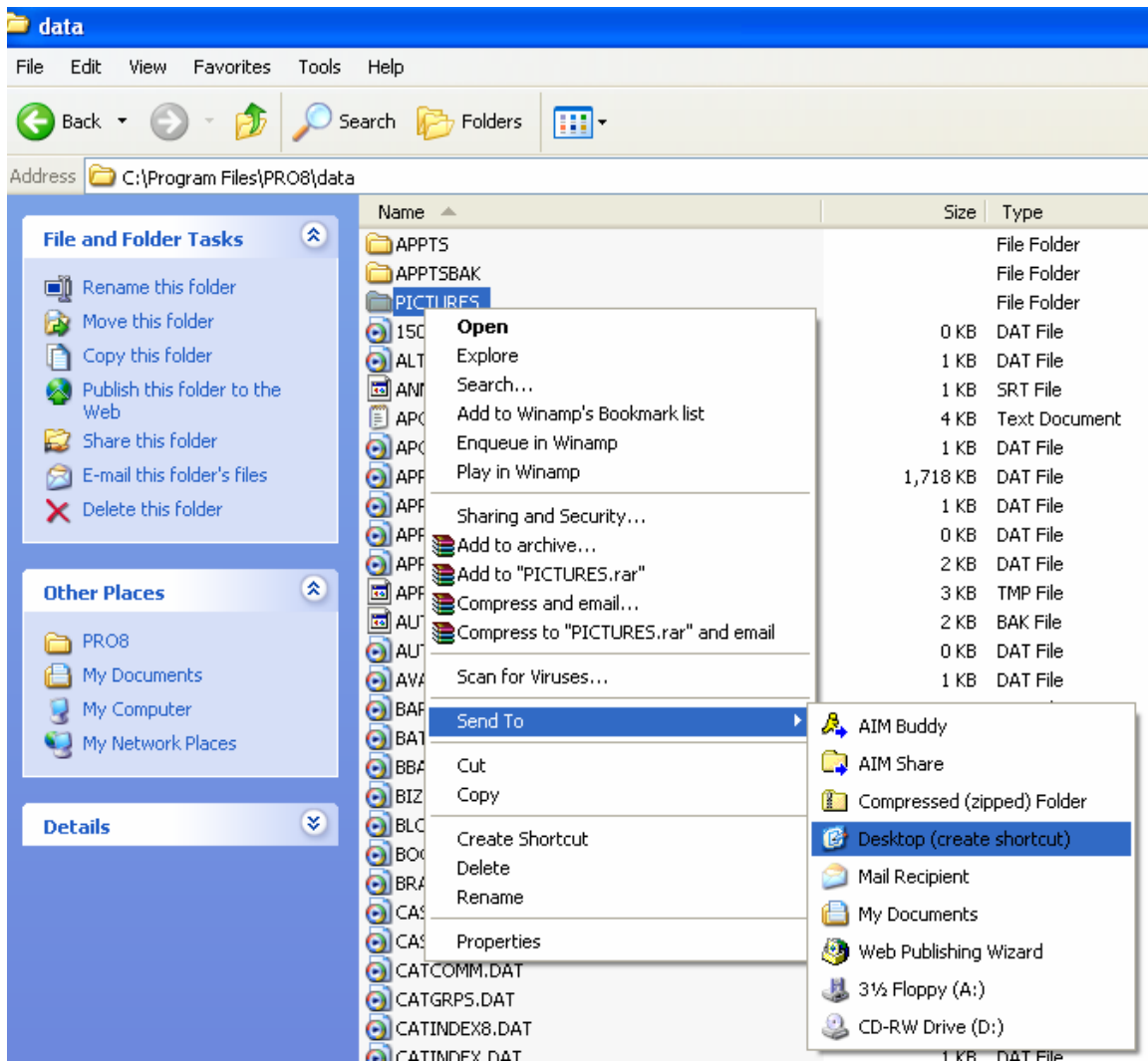
First you will need to go to setup/preferences/clients.



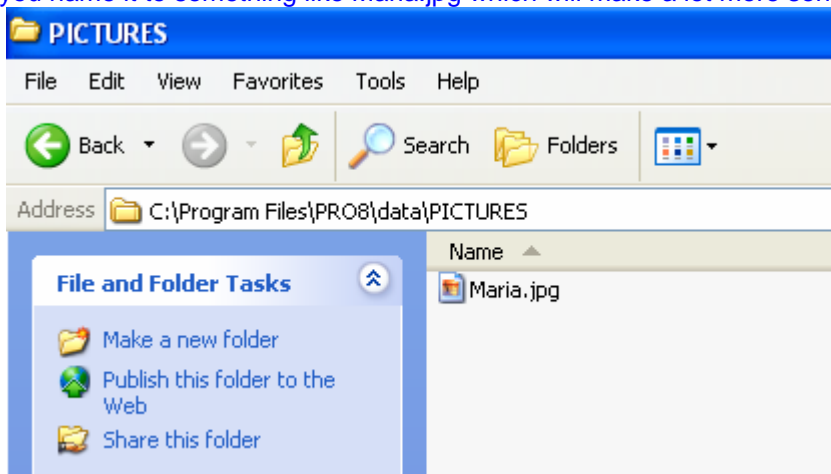
Place a checkmark in 'enable client picture display' and click SAVE.



This will create a folder named "photos" as a sub-directory of the Data folder. You will need to copy your photos into that folder. For easier use we recommend you make a shortcut to this folder right on your desktop.



We also suggest you rename the photos so instead of having a photo named 00031233234.jpg you name it to something like Maria.jpg which will make a lot more sense to you.



Once that's done you can go into the client information screen and click the photo's button. It will ask you for the picture name i.e. Out On The Town, then the name of the file which is Maria.jpg.
